Mr Renny Yeo is a seasoned business leader and respected board director with deep expertise in corporate governance, standardisation, and industrial development across Singapore and the region. He was appointed as a member of the SMF's Board of Governors on 25 June 2025. He currently serves as an Independent Non-Executive Director of Tai Sin Electric Ltd, a company listed on the Singapore Exchange (SGX), as well as Zicom Holdings Pte Ltd and its parent company, Zicom Group Ltd, which is listed on the Australian Securities Exchange (ASX). He also holds a Non-Executive Directorship at KPH Properties Holdings Sdn Bhd and its group of subsidiaries in Malaysia.

Mr Yeo contributes actively to the business advisory ecosystem as a member of the Singapore Business Advisors and Consultants Council (SBACC), supporting enterprise development and management excellence. His longstanding association with the Singapore Manufacturing Federation (SMF) reflects his deep commitment to industry transformation. He was elected President of SMF from 2008 to 2010, subsequently appointed Emeritus President from 2010 to 2014 and again from 2019 to 2021, and served on the SMF Board of Governors from 2014 to 2019.

Beyond the private sector, Mr Yeo has held numerous appointments on public sector boards and national councils. These include serving on the boards of Enterprise Singapore (ESG), SPRING Singapore, the Productivity & Standards Board, and the Building and Construction Authority (BCA). He also played a key role in promoting sustainability and technical standards as Chairman of the Singapore Accreditation Council, and as a member of the Singapore Green Building Council.

Additionally, Mr Yeo contributed to the advancement of national and international standards through his involvement in the Standardisation Council under SPRING Singapore, the Electrical & Electronic Product Standards Committee, and as Chair of the Singapore National Committee of the International Electrotechnical Commission (IEC). Through his multifaceted leadership, Mr Yeo has made significant contributions to Singapore's manufacturing competitiveness, standards development, and enterprise ecosystem.
